

MOVING TOWARD A TRANSGENDER AFFIRMATIVE CLINICAL PRACTICE SEAN LARE, LCSW-C

CONFERENCE SUMMARY

As more individuals are able to live their lives as themselves, as their affirmed gender; and as more insurance companies offer benefits inclusive of gender affirming medical procedures; behavioral health providers are increasingly being contacted by transgender and gender diverse individuals for care. Effective mental health and substance use disorder treatment with transgender and gender diverse clients requires psychotherapists to create a safe and affirming treatment environment, as well as to develop specialized clinical competencies and considerations. Moving toward a transgender affirmative clinical practice is an ethical imperative for all clinicians today.

This interactive workshop is designed to help practitioners address biases and attitudes that undermine therapeutic safety, increase provider knowledge of gender minorities, and discuss the clinical issues facing transgender and gender diverse clients. Both clinical and administrative considerations will be presented to ensure that clinical practices are ethical, affirming, and inclusive from start to finish. Participant will leave with clinical competencies to better meet the growing and evolving demands of this population.

OBJECTIVES

- Participants will demonstrate knowledge of the ethical responsibility to understand the unique challenges and needs of transgender and gender diverse people.
- Participants will explore terms & language related to transgender clients.
- Participants will examine and increase their comfort, knowledge, and ability to provide services to people who are transgender.
- Participants will discuss clinical, ethical, and administrative guidance for creating a safe, therapeutic environment for addressing the needs of gender minorities.
