^{**} In Pennsylvania "supervised clinical experience" conforms to the following: "At least 1/2 of the experience shall consist of providing services in one or more of the following areas: (i) Assessment; (ii) Psychotherapy; (iii) Other psychosocial-therapeutic interventions; (iv) Consultation; (v) Family therapy; (vi) Group therapy." "3 years of supervised clinical experience" means "three 12-month periods during each of which the applicant has completed at least 1,000 hours." The three 12-month periods need not be consecutive but must be completed within 6 years.
